1. Introduction

As a Masternode and Staking coin, [CazCoin](#) masternode owners and stakers are handsomely rewarded to continuously operate the blockchain. Staking your coins can be a great way to earn rewards and build your portfolio, for little to no charge!

To stake you will need to keep your coins in your unlocked wallet and keep your PC on 24/7.

Note: This guide is intended to provide a high-level overview of staking using the CazCoin wallet; it does not go in to all the possible configurations of staking. For more information on staking, perform a Google search – there are many resources out there for you to research.

2. Requirements

- Caz Coins. These can be purchased via:
 - [Coinexchange](#); or
 - [Cryptobridge](#).

Note: Check [CazCoin website](#) for up-to-date exchange listings.
- Download the latest CazCoin wallet via the [CazCoin website](#). After it's downloaded, ensure its fully synced before beginning;
- In your wallet, go to **Settings > Options > Wallet**, and tick the box for 'Enable coin control features' (this helps you split your coins up to smaller inputs); and
- Ensure your wallet is encrypted (always do this). Go to **Options > Encrypt Wallet** and choose a safe, unique password. Do not forget this password. When finished, exit the wallet and reopen.

Note: Back up your wallet regularly. Do after creating new addresses within your wallet.

A good practice is to store the backed-up wallet.dat file on an encrypted USB drive or hard drive and store offsite.


3. Local Wallet Setup

Once your local wallet has synced, go to:

- **File > Receiving Addresses**
- Click **New**

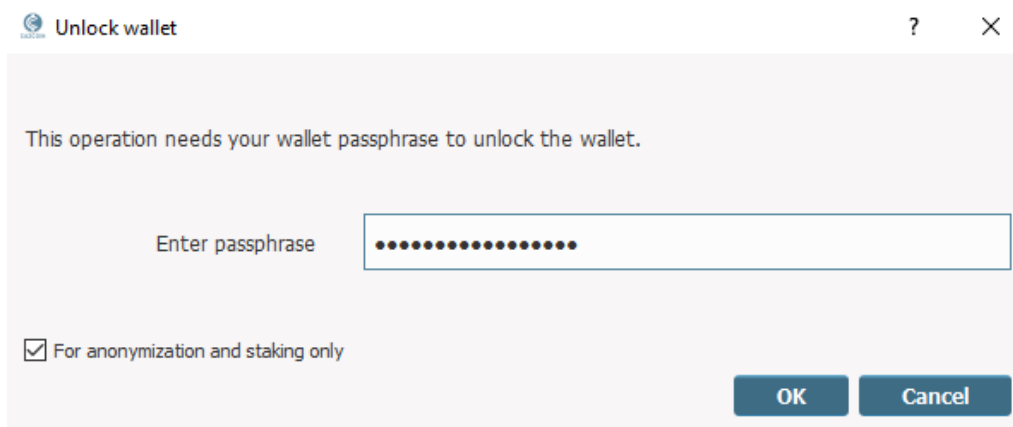
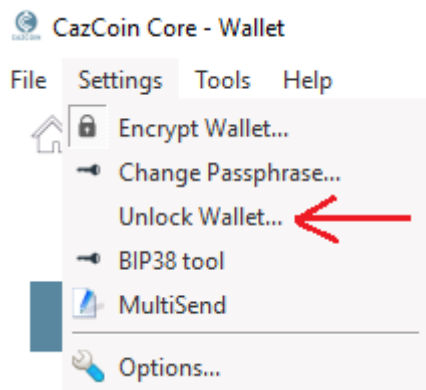
Here you will label your receiving address to something easy to remember, such as 'Staking'

- Click **OK** to generate an address.



Once you've clicked OK the new address will then be displayed. Copy this address.

- Send the coins to your new address from the exchange (if that's where they are).
- Go to **Settings > Unlock Wallet**
- Type in your password and click the tickbox 'For Staking and Optimisation Only'.



Once the wallet is unlocked, it should display as unlocked and staking in the bottom right corner. If you hover your mouse over the lock icon it will say it's unlocked for staking only, and the up arrow should be in green – this means you're staking!



Another way to check is to go in to your debug console via **Tools > Debug Console**, then typing:

getstakingstatus

Press **Enter**

The console then should show a response of 'True' for the outputs.

4. Time to Stake

Your coin inputs hit a minimum of 101 confirmations before they'll start to stake, however the frequency of your coins staking will depend on how many coins you have versus the network weight (total amount of coins staking).

For example: Joe has 1000 coins in a single input, and Steve has 2000 coins in a single input. In this instance Steve would have a higher chance of receiving a stake reward than Joe.

At the time of writing it's recommended that a minimum of 2500 coins are required for the best chance of receiving a reward daily.

Once your coins earn a staking reward, they'll have to reach the number of confirmations again before they'll stake.

5. Troubleshooting

Firewall:

If your wallet won't open/continually closes, ensure your antivirus (e.g. Windows Defender) is not blocking the CazCoin program.
